## Number bingo

Resources:

- Paper
- Colouring pencils

Make a number board with the numbers $0-10$ on it and try to play against another family member in your house. Try make it a little harder by mixing up the numbers and leaving a number out as there is only enough space for 10 numbers.
You will also need to make some number cards to flip over with numbers 0-10 Just like this (I missed out number 7)

| 1 | 0 | 8 | 3 | 5 |
| :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- |
| 10 | 4 | 8 | 0 | 2 |

Same rules as Bingo, (flip cards, roll a dice, use a clock anything you can find at home to use) over to see which number you have to cover.

First person to cover all their numbers wins!
Writing your own numbers is tricky. Try practise before writing them on your card.
