School - Covid-19 Protection Framework 'Orange Settings'

School is a controlled environment to ensure we can keep our tamariki and staff as safe as possible from the transmission of Covid-19, the following controls are presently in place:

- We continue our staggered start and finish times to ensure no crossing of whanau bubbles and the safety of our tamariki with all the building work happening directly around our school site
- Designated toilet facilities for our tamariki (we have contracted 2 sets of portable toilet blocks to ensure this)
- Designated play areas
- Our staff wear surgical masks inside classrooms
- Our tamariki in years 4 and above wear school provided surgical masks inside classrooms
- No visitors on site to reduce the risk of transmission of C-19 for our tamariki and staff
- External agencies, Contractors and urgent visits on site require prior approval from Tumuaki and C-19 H&S Officer
- Ventilation of classrooms is maintained at 18 to 20 degrees
- MoE are providing limited portable air cleaners and CO2 monitors as part of the ventilation toolkit for schools
- Children and staff who are unwell must stay away from school

<u>Absences</u>

Please contact your teacher or our administration office team if your child is going to be away from school. Teachers follow up all absences in their classrooms.
